Winemaking Notes

We have returned to the Harvey Vineyard in Lodi, part of the Vino Con Brio estate, to produce another beautiful Zinfandel. After careful hand harvesting the grapes were fermented in small lots utilizing a specialty yeast D254 to enhance the bright fruit qualities of Zinfandel. The wine was aged for 20 months in mostly new French oak.

Tasting Notes

Raspberry, blueberry and floral aromas bound from the glass. Hints of chocolate and cassis add to the broad aroma profile. A perfect wine for summer BBQ and other lively occasions.
