We are pleased to announce “Dulcinea”, the first dry white wine to come under the WAV banner. The Roussanne and Pinot Grigio come from the Lodi estate vineyard of Vino Con Brio (I am their Winemaker) and the Viognier from our estate vineyard.

Dulcinea is a blend of relatively new varieties to California, two of which originated in the Rhone Valley in the south of France (Roussanne and Viognier) and the other is the main white variety of northern Italy and Alsace (Pinot Grigio/Pinot Gris)

Fermented and aged entirely in stainless steel I was striving to keep the bright fruit and still develop a rich character to the wine.

In our Dulcinea the Roussanne brings a rich floral and banana component to the aromas. The Viognier adds hints of apricot and pear. The flinty finish of the Pinot Grigio adds length to the wine.

This wine will be perfect match for a summer picnic or grilled fresh-caught fish.
