**Winemaking Notes**

The extremely popular Iowa Hill continues as a unique Rhone inspired wine with a California twist. Carignane is an old variety in California, originally from the Rhone region of south France. Planted extensively in California in the early 1900s as a variety that thrived in the Lodi / Delta area. The Carignane and Zinfandel both come from the Manassero Vineyard, a Lodi vineyard planted in the 1940's.

**Tasting Notes**

Strawberry, blueberry, violets and spice spring from the glass. Moderately full bodied yet supple in finish, this is a great wine to enjoy with any spring and summer fare.
